


Wellmark Specialty Drug List



Specialty drugs are high-cost injectable, infused, oral, or inhaled drugs for the ongoing treatment of a chronic condition. These drugs generally require close supervision and monitoring of the patient's drug therapy.

The drugs on this list are considered Specialty Drugs, as defined by Wellmark, and are covered under the Specialty Drug Program as follows:

SELF-ADMINISTERED SPECIALTY DRUGS — Specialty drugs only covered under your drug plan, typically administered by the member, and limited to a 30-day supply per cost share. These drugs are not available through the 90-day mail order program.

OFFICE ADMINISTERED SPECIALTY DRUGS — Office administered specialty drugs are drugs typically associated with an office procedure or require skilled administration (intravenous therapy, etc.) These drugs are always payable under your health benefit, no matter where you purchase them. Your health benefit deductible and out-of-pocket maximum may apply.

NOTE: This list may not be all-inclusive and is subject to change. Certain drugs may require prior authorization and all drugs listed may not be covered under your specific plan.
