FY21-14 UPFIT POLICE CRUISERS

Questions are in black and answers from the City are in red. The following clarifications have been released by the City of Council Bluffs:

October 14, 2020

1. At the beginning of the bid spec in the legal notice it says there will be 5 vehicles that need to be stripped, but then at the end when it restates the work to be done before giving you a line for the total it says there are only 4 vehicles. How many vehicles need to be stripped?

Page 16 is incorrect. There are five vehicles to strip and five new vehicles to upfit. Please cross out the word "four" on page 16 and replace it with "five".

2. It talks about the insurance needed for a contractor to have that lists City of Council Bluffs, but it doesn't say if that needs to be shown upon submittal or before any work will be done on the vehicles.

Insurance certificates are not required for the bid submittal. Adequate insurance will be requested upon award and will need to be provided before contract execution.

3. It says there needs to be documentation on the parts being used, does that only mean parts that may be equal but not exact to the specified parts?

All parts are to be exactly as specified. No requests for alternates were received by the deadline. Diagrams/brochures are not required for items specified by the City.
